As one of the UK’s leading lights in regenerative medicine, Mr Banwell is also a specialist in ‘mummy makeovers’ – one or more plastic surgery body procedures for women who have had children. These procedures may be small ‘nips and tucks’, or more major combinations, such as tummy tuck with breast augmentation



(implants), breast lift with tummy tuck, breast augmentation and labiaplasty, breast reduction and liposuction, or hybrid breast augmentation with mini tummy tuck.

The author of a bestselling book on intimate rejuvenation, Mr Banwell offers a full range of both surgical and non-surgical treatments ‘down below’ (he even has a classification named after him). ‘Puffing’ the labia majora (outer lips) is the latest in-demand technique and Mr Banwell was the first in the UK to introduce a novel version: the nanospring labial puff technique using innovative APTOS threads from Novus Medical.

Mr Banwell’s professional reach encompasses the non-surgical too. He has introduced ARTIS supplements to support patients through their procedures, and beyond.
